The following are the dates applicable for admission to Limerick Community Special School.

Our school caters for children whose primary diagnosis is Moderate Intellectual learning Disability and complex needs, who have an educational recommendation for a special school setting. The Criteria for Admission is set out in the School's Admission & Participation Policy for the school year 2026-2027.

<i>The school will commence accepting applications for Admission on:</i>	06/02/2026
<i>The school shall cease accepting applications for Admission by 12pm on</i>	27/02/2026 at Midday
<i>The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is:</i>	13/03/2026
<i>The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of Admission is:</i>	27/03/2026 at Midday

Applications are only accepted by Post or hand delivered to the school.

Email Applications are not accepted

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.

Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above, or that stated on any letter of offer, may result in the offer being withdrawn.

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.
